

### School Reopens January 31, 2022

Students and staff members were very happy to see one another in person, when the Sathya Sai School building reopened its doors on Monday, January 31, 2022. The joy of teaching and of learning was felt by both teachers and students as they worked together through the day.

We are very grateful to the Sathya Sai School's Board of Directors, the Building Management Team, the IT team, Parent Council and Volunteers for working long hours to keep the school safe for the students and staff members.

Many safety measures have been put into place during the school's virtual classes in the month of January. These include:

- Daily health screening tool
- Triple layer masks and PPEs
- Cleaning hands throughout the day
- Cohorting of classes and social distancing
- Adjustments to classroom desks and rooms to ensure distancing
- Medical Room
- Ventilation and Air Quality Assessments
- Medical grade thermometers in each classroom
- Daily cleaning and onsite custodian cleaning of all high traffic areas including washrooms and doors
- Deep cleaning and fogging of school regularly
- School-wide programs have been moved online, such as the Year-End Concert and Public Speaking.
- Contact sports and use of gym equipment are on hold; in Music, no singing or wind instruments.
- Mental health backdrop for all class curricula.




A.R Rahman questions, facts, answers

Who is the Tamil physicist Nobel Prize for Physics for his work on the structure and evolution of stars?

Well, His name is Subrahmanyan Chandrasekhar and he was born in 1910 in Lahore, which at the time was in British India. Subrahmanyan Chandrasekhar was one of the foremost astrophysicists of the twentieth century. Chandra proved that there was an upper limit to the mass of a white dwarf. This limit, known as the Chandra limit, showed that stars more massive than the Sun would explode or form black holes as they died. Chandra also developed theories on star atmospheres, black holes, the illumination of the sunlit sky, star structures and star mass.


Discover the truth, and do not rush to conclusions, always keeping love as your guide.
